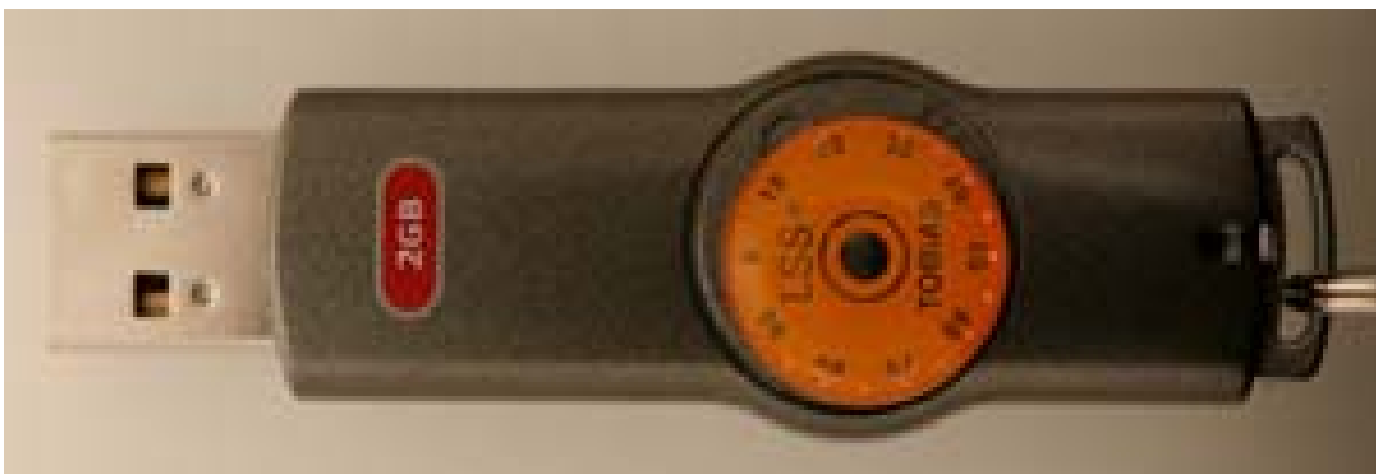


DAME 2007 USB

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



The distinctive orange logo indicates that the DAME version is contained on the USB drive. There are two different versions of this drive; one for UPDATE and one for NEW INSTALLATION.

The 2007 version of DAME has been released. This special supplement to *LSS+* was originally issued in 2005 and contains approximately sixty video segments with Harry Sher and Marc Tobias discussing methods of covert and forced entry. The video is also linked to detailed text and photographs that are contained in *LSS+ 2007*. Once you install DAME from USB you can upgrade to the new edition of *LSS+* by obtaining an unlock code for the appropriate license.

If you purchased the original two-volume CD ROM set, it required a separate unlock code because it was issued subsequent to the Version 5.0 release of *LSS+*. Depending upon whether you UPGRADE your current DAME version or are purchasing DAME for the first time will determine whether you need another unlock code. Please read and follow the installation and operating instructions to protect the information on the USB drive from corruption and to insure that you can open and view the different video files without difficulty.

The DAME 2007 software is currently provided only on USB 2GB flash drive because the file size of LSS501 exceeds the capacity of a CD ROM. Many users do not have a DVD drive so we elected to utilize flash memory to replace the CD ROM.

PLEASE NOTE THERE ARE TWO VERSIONS OF DAME 2007:

Upgrade to Version 5.0 (which used Folio Software version 4.6) that is currently installed on your computer, and a **new installation** that uses **Folio Views software version 4.7**. The latest version of Folio software contains significant security enhancements.

The supplement will also be released as part of **LSS+** on DVD later in 2007. There are two separate Infobase files contained in the DAME supplement: LSS501 and LSS502. All of the new video segments have been added to LSS501.

There are several different installation procedures that depend on whether you currently have the DAME CD set or whether you are purchasing the 2007 version for the first time. Please determine which procedure to follow based upon one of the listed conditions.

For current owners:

You currently have a copy of DAME installed on your hard drive and want to upgrade the LSS501 files;

You currently have a copy of DAME on CD ROM but did not install the files on your hard drive. You run the CD to view the files;

You currently have both **LSS+** and DAME licenses enabled.

New Installation of DAME on your hard drive

You have just purchased a copy of DAME 2007 and do not have **LSS+** on your computer;

You have **LSS+** on your computer and wish to add DAME 2007 for the first time;

New Installation of DAME to run from the USB drive

You only wish to install the system files on your hard drive and view the video files directly from the USB drive. Note: the video files required approximately 1.4 GB of memory.

NOTES ON THE USE OF THE USB DRIVE

The Memorex Travel Drive is a high quality memory device. The USB drive has a 2GB capacity. Approximately 1.4GB is required for DAME. That means that you can load other files on the drive. Note that there are some Memorex systems files contained on this drive. You may wish to delete those if desired but we do not recommend it. Although flash memory is fairly robust it can be damaged or the files corrupted. Whenever files are being read or written the blue LED will flash. In order to protect the DAME files, NEVER REMOVE THE DRIVE WHILE IT IS ACTIVELY READING OR WRITING. In most operating systems there is a taskbar icon that you can click to safely remove the drive. We recommend this although it usually will not damage the drive simply to unplug it when idle.

When you first insert the drive into your computer the Windows XP, VISTA or 2000 operating system will recognize the new hardware and install it. If you are running

Windows 98, you may need a special driver file. Once the operating system advises that your USB drive has been installed and is ready for use, it is just like any other disk drive. You may find the drive in MY COMPUTER. It should be labeled DAME2007.

Please be certain to avoid dropping the drive or exposing it to static electricity.

You can copy the contents of the USB drive to other hard disks on one or more computers but you will require an unlock code to run the software. All of the DAME software can be run on the USB drive if you desire.

If you are installing DAME for the first time the files will be located in c:\[program files\lss2007](#).

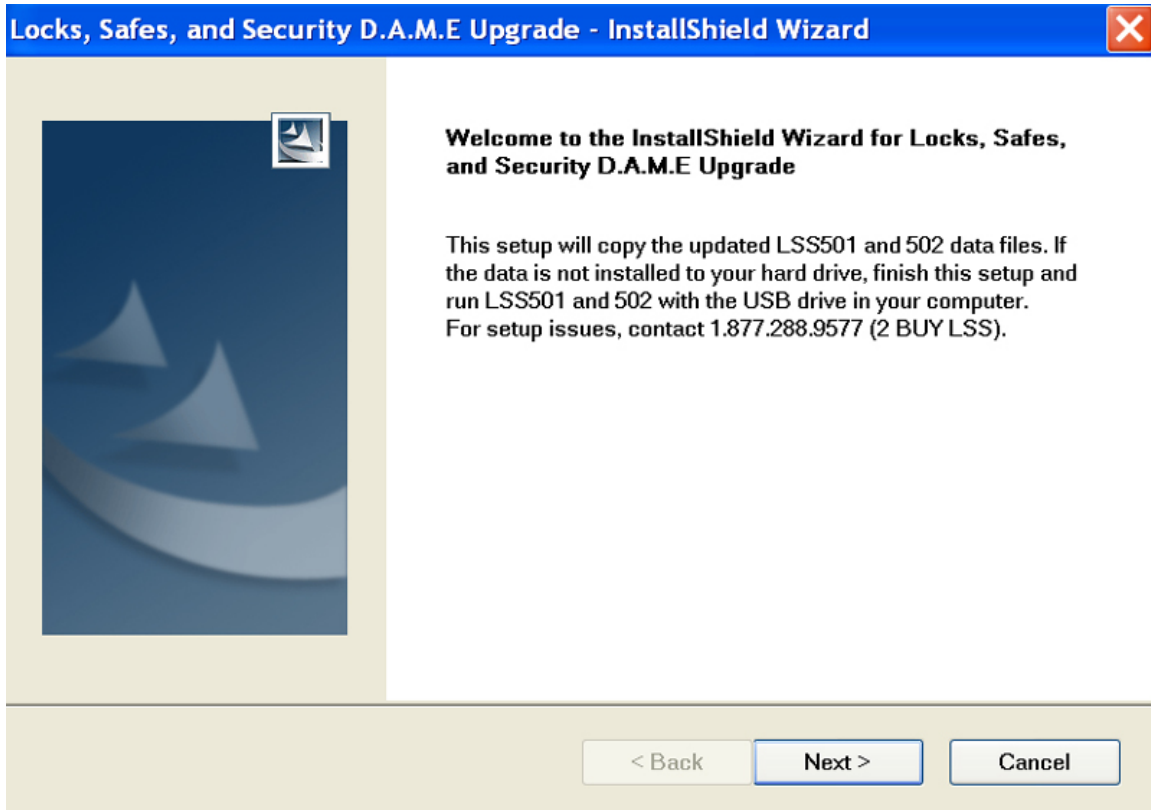
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR CURRENT OWNERS OF DAME 5.0

You currently have a copy of DAME installed on your hard drive and want to upgrade the LSS501 files that contain the latest video segments.

In this case you simply wish to update the files contained within LSS501 that are installed on your hard drive or that you read from the CD ROM. You must use the UPDATE USB. This will have a red dot to indicate that it is running Folio 4.6 software and is compatible with your current installation.

The update version will only work if you currently have the DAME system files installed on your computer and have previously obtained an unlock code. You will **not** need to obtain a new unlock code to run the update files. Once installed, DAME will run in the same mode as before, regardless of whether you copied the contents of the CD ROM to your hard drive or ran the program from the CD directly.

To install the software, insert the UPDATE drive into a USB port, then go to MY COMPUTER and locate the DAME2007 drive. Select the drive and select **SETUP.EXE** once all of the files are displayed. You will see the following window.



Follow the prompts and complete the installation. You can either run LSS501 or LSS502 from your hard drive or USB drive, by selecting the program icons under the START>ALL PROGRAMS menu.

You currently have a copy of DAME on CD ROM but did not install the files on your hard drive. You insert the proper CD to view the files.

The installation routine works the same way as if you had copied LSS501 and LSS502 to your hard drive. Simply follow the install routine.

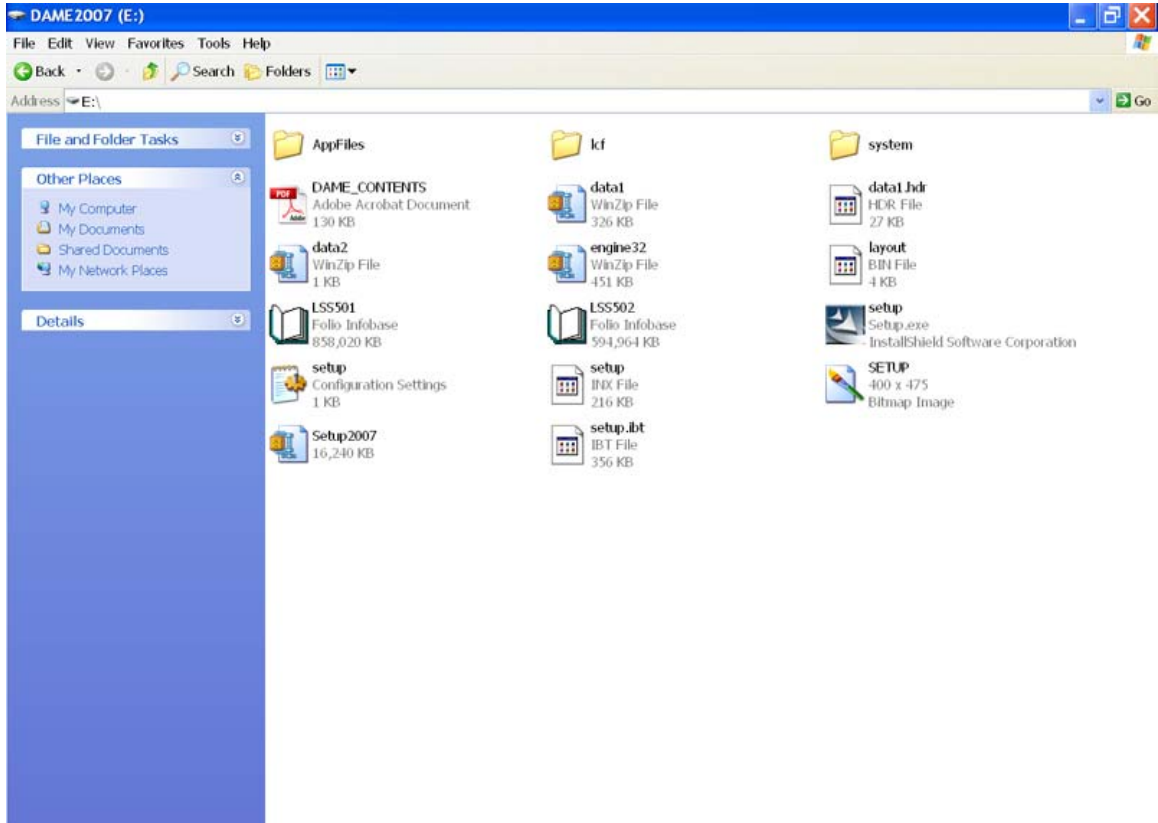
You currently have both LSS+ and DAME licenses enabled.

The same update procedure applies. You will have two separate unlock codes that have been previously issued. You should not notice any difference in operation from Version 5.0 that was currently installed.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR INITIAL INSTALL ON YOUR HARD DRIVE

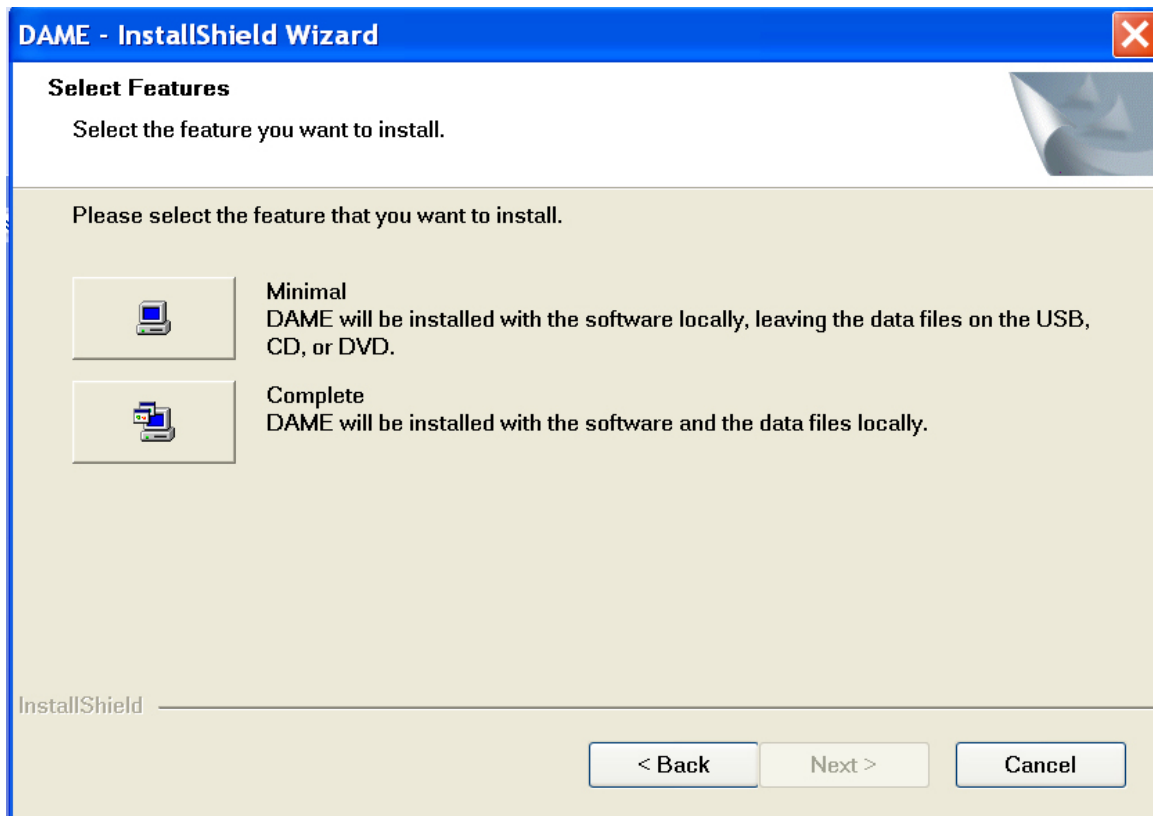
You have just purchased a copy of DAME 2007 and do not have LSS+ on your computer.

Insert the USB drive and then go to MY COMPUTER and click on the DAME2007 icon. When the contents of the directory are displayed, click on **Setup.exe** and run the install.



All of the files on the USB drive are displayed.

You will be asked whether you would like to copy the contents of the drive onto your hard drive. This will require about 1.4GB of hard disk space. If you prefer, you can copy only the Folio software to your hard drive (which requires about 30 MB). The LSS501 and LSS502 files can be run directly from the USB drive.



You have *LSS+* on your computer and wish to add DAME 2007 for the first time;

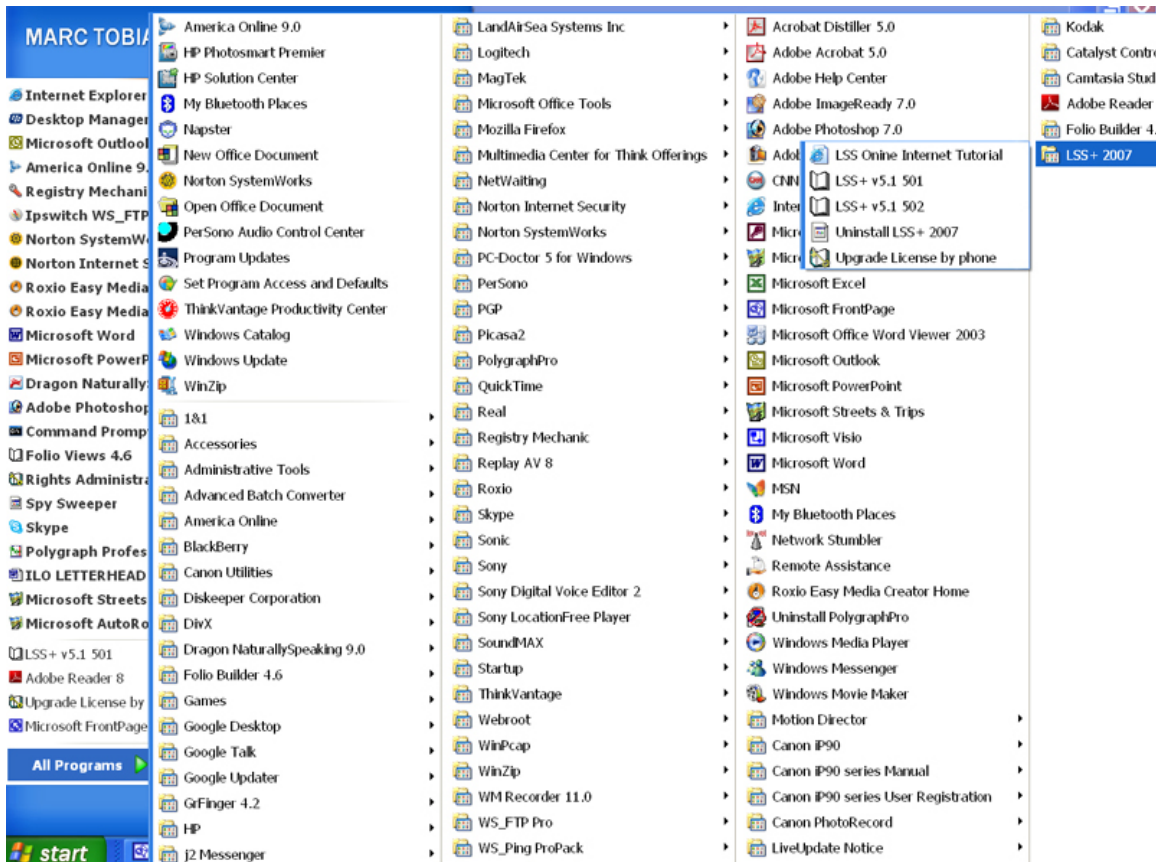
The same procedure applies as above. You will have to obtain an unlock code before the program can be opened. See the procedure below to generate a challenge key and to obtain an unlock code.

New Installation of DAME to run from the USB drive

You only wish to install the **system files** on your hard drive and view the video files directly from the USB drive. Just click the desired option during the install procedure.

OPENING FILES ON THE USB DRIVE

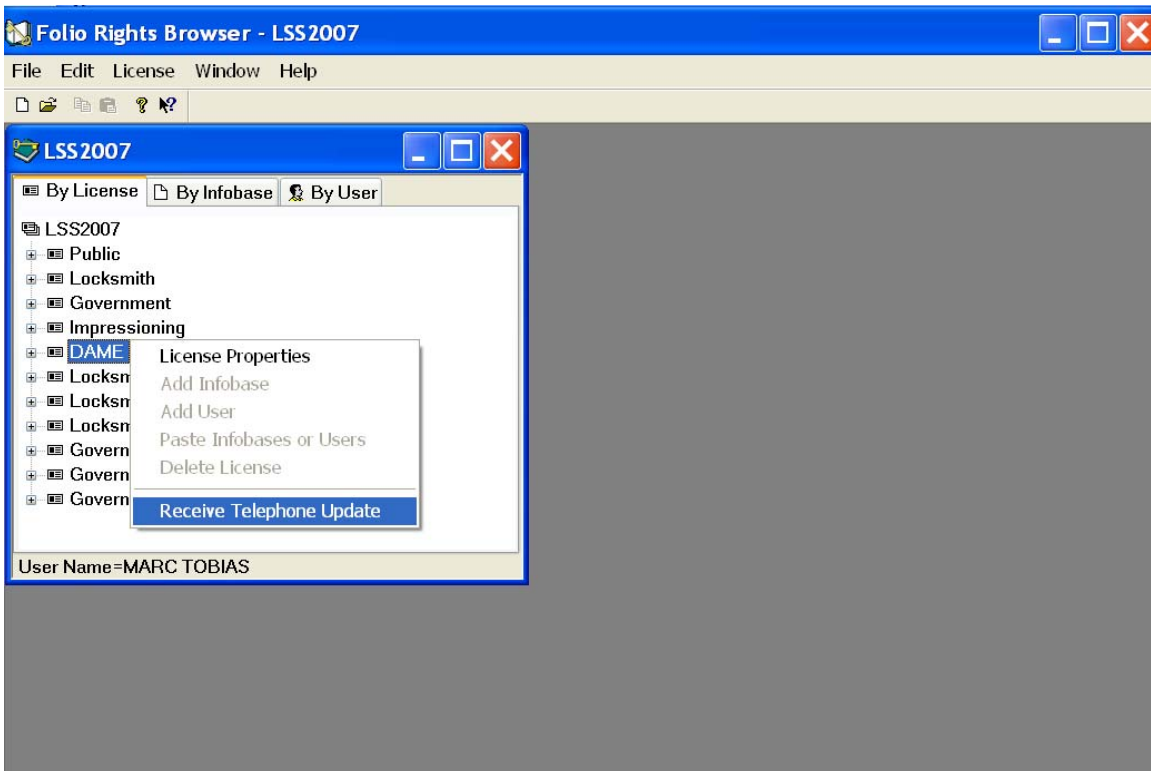
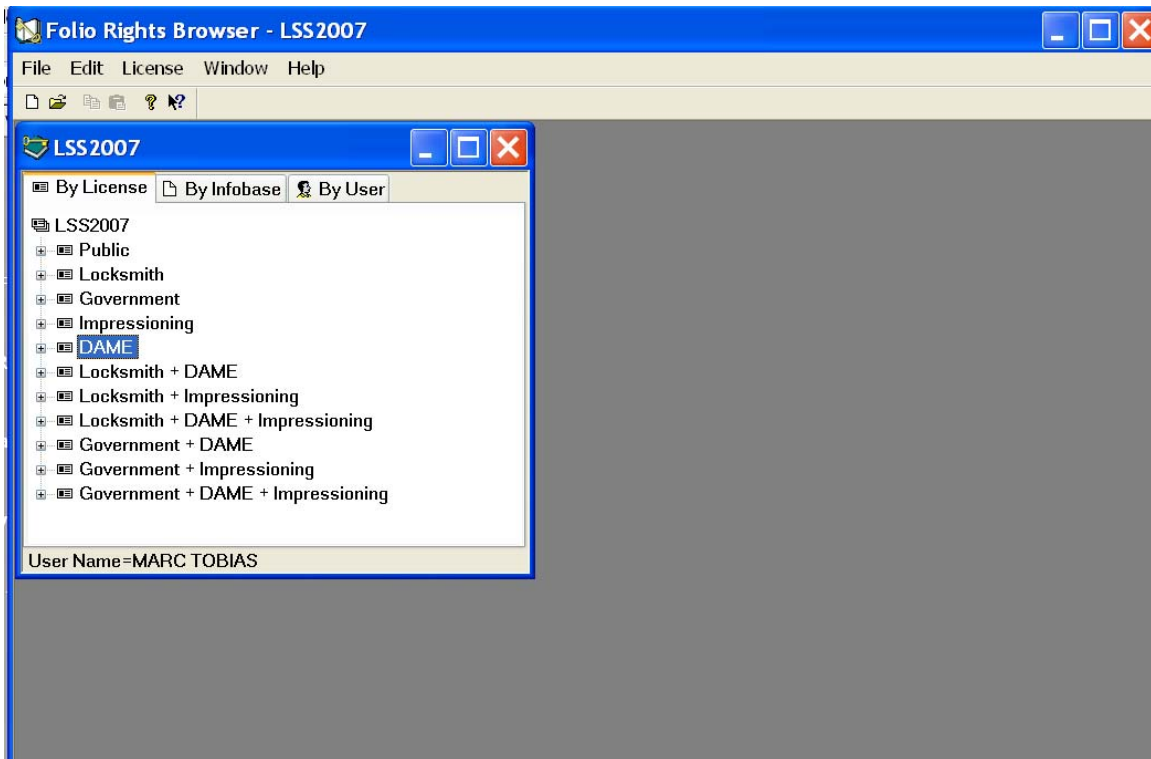
You can access files from the icons on your desktop or the listing in the program group under *LSS+* 2007. Then click on LSS501 or LSS502.



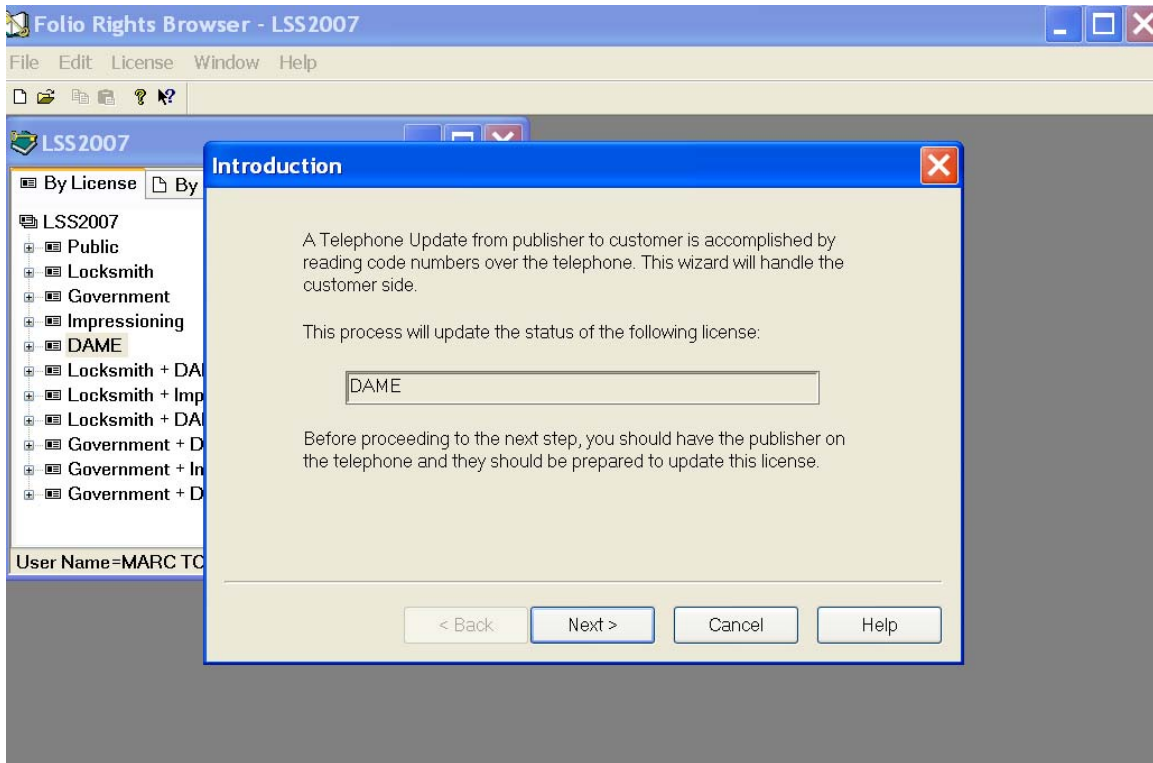
OBTAINING AN UNLOCK CODE

If you have installed DAME2007 for the first time you must obtain an unlock code. You may do this by email or by phone. If by email, generate a challenge key and send it to mwtobias@security.org or hsher@starband.net. You may also call toll free 1.877.228.9577, however we prefer you to email the code. To generate a challenge key, follow the procedure outlined below. It is the same as detailed in the tutorial at www.security.org/lss-tour.htm. Once the challenge key is generated, you can COPY the key by highlighting it and pressing CTRL-C. Then paste it into an email by pressing CTRL-V.

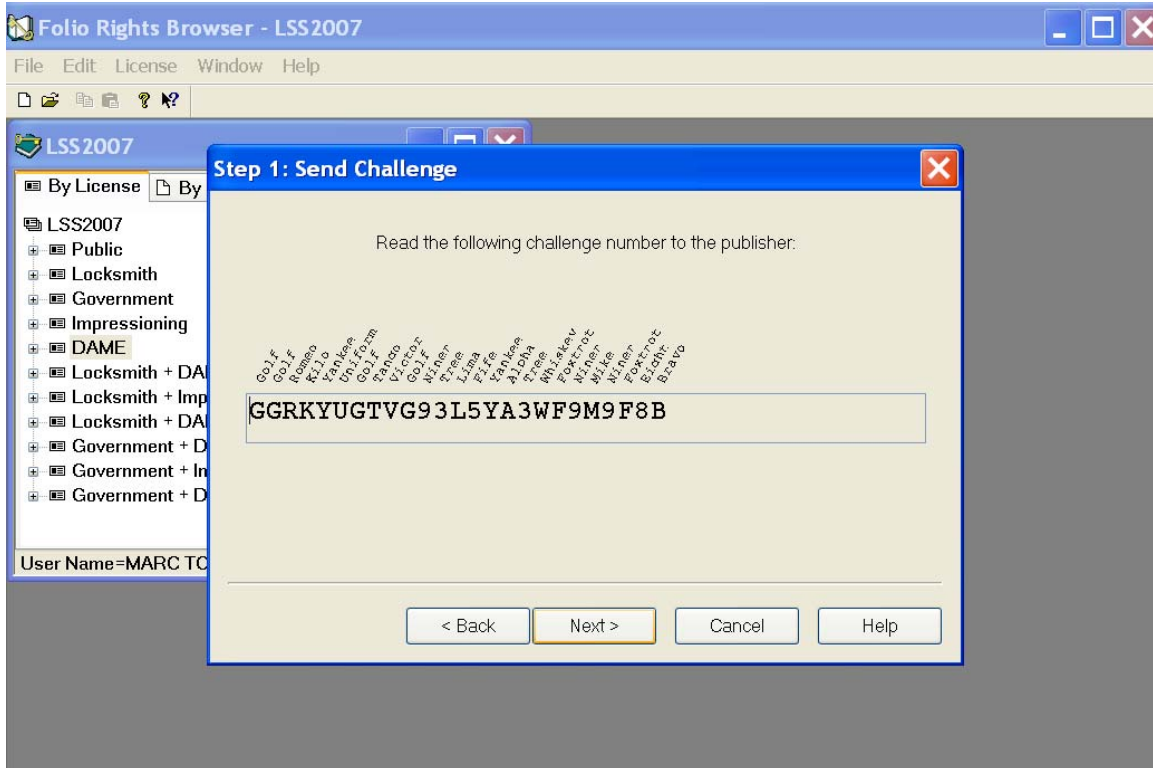
Highlight but do not click UPDATE LICENSE BY PHONE from the LSS+ 2007 Program Group. Then right click once on the highlighted DAME.



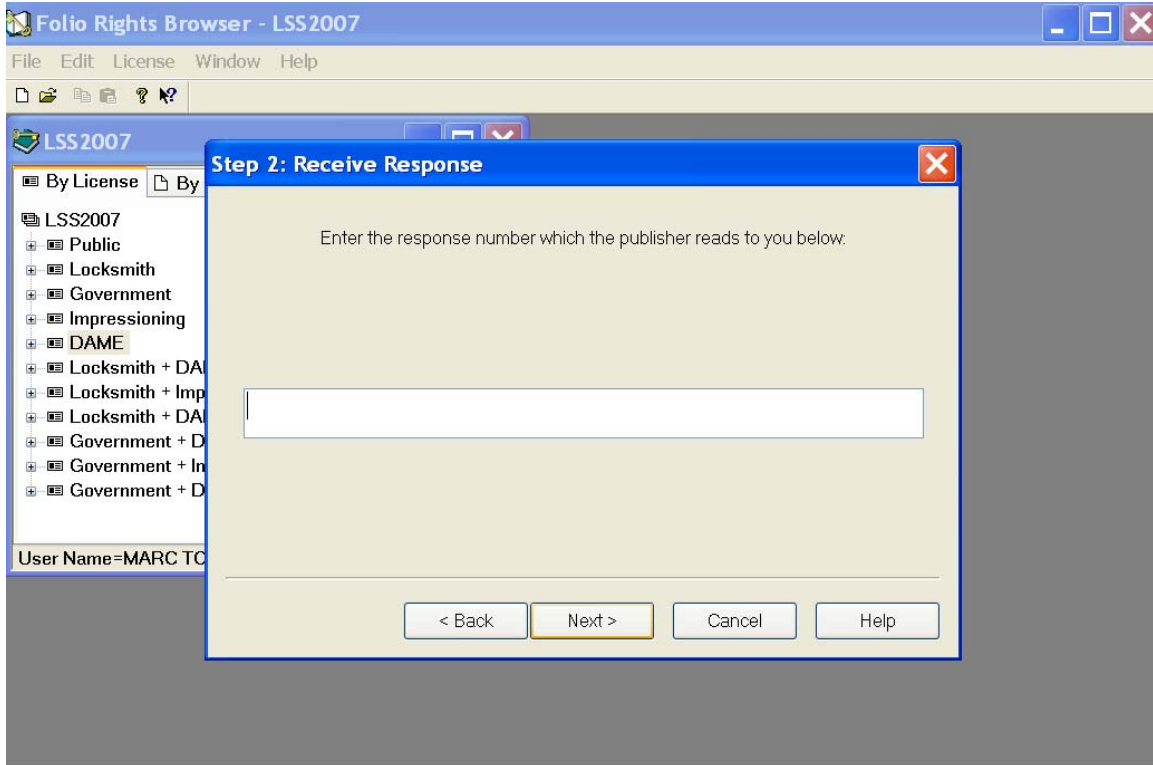
Select the option RECEIVE TELEPHONE UPDATE.



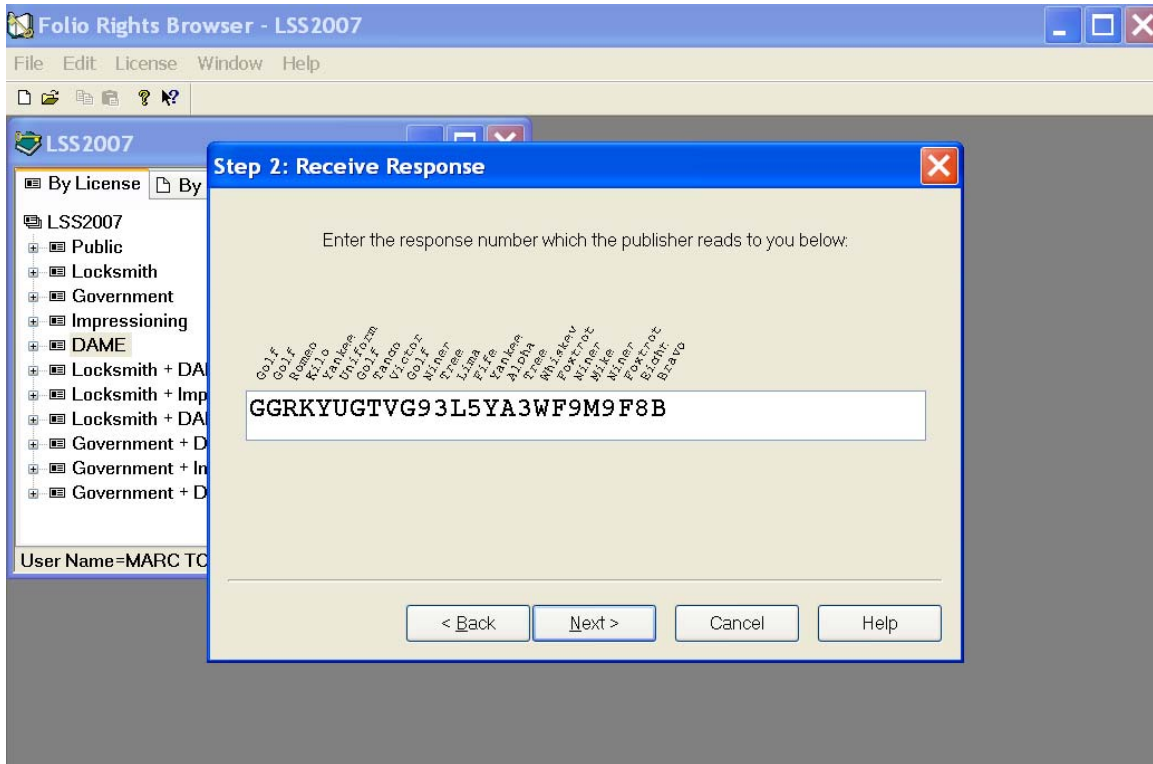
Click NEXT to display a challenge key.



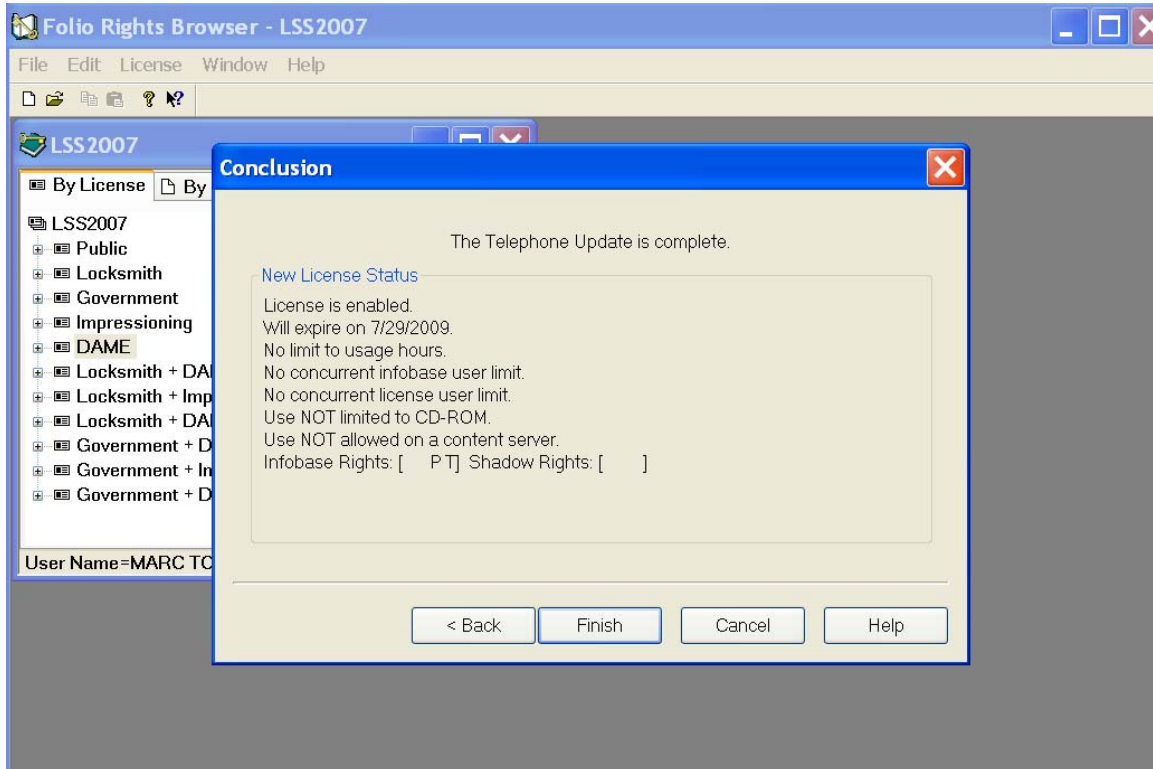
Copy this key and email it in order to receive an unlock code. Then click NEXT in order to create an entry window when you receive the unlock code. BE CERTAIN TO LEAVE THE PROGRAM RUNNING UNTIL YOU RECEIVE THE UNLOCK CODE.



Enter the response into the blank window as shown below.



Click NEXT to show the status of your license.



Click FINISH to complete the process. You may then launch DAME from the program group by clicking on LSS501 or LSS502.
